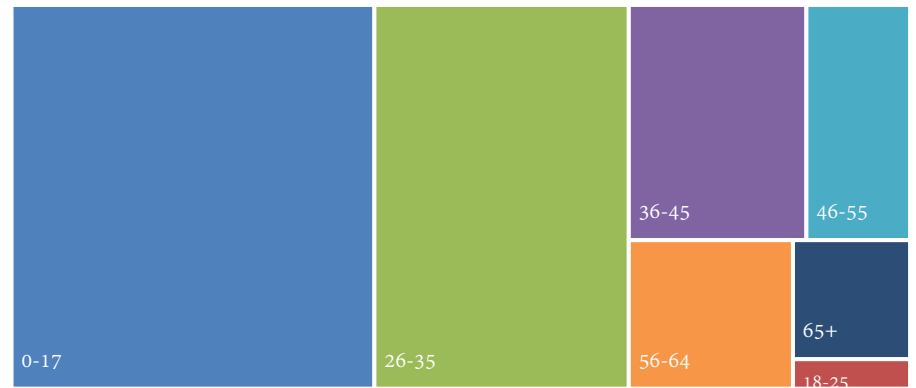
## Mid-Year Report

**Kymari House** provides court-ordered supervised visitation services to families impacted by SUD/ODU and Community stigma trainings.

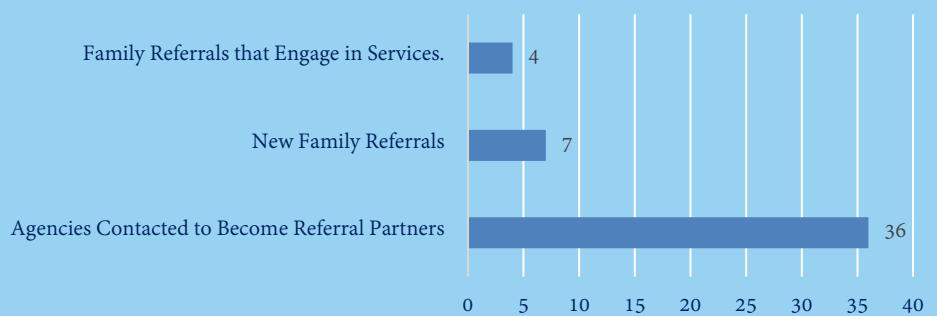
Serving **40 minors** and **59 parents** or guardians, at the mid-point no households were dismissed from the program due to negative or harmful behaviors.

HOPE Trainings provide education on the importance of positive childhood experiences, how PCEs build protective factors for children exposed to ACEs and SUD/ODU within the household.

### Referral Engagement

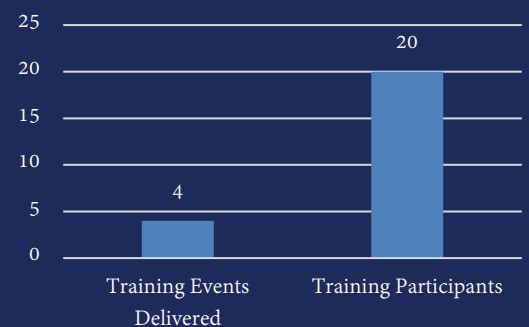


### Family Engagement



Kymari House provided 89 supervised visits to participating families. In total, ROB provided 147.5 hours of supervised visitation to families impacted by SUD/ODU.

Utilizing pre-post surveys, 100% of HOPE training attendees documented increased knowledge in ACEs & SUD awareness content.
